

Conscience

- Conscience only works when we inform it, when we learn the moral truth.
- The Church helps us to do that through the Magisterium . . . giving us the Catechism, which tells us what the moral issues are and why they are, based on Scripture.
- Your conscience is the voice of truth, not your feelings – it is the activity of your intellect judging actions as right or wrong. Feelings and opinions need to be governed by conscience in order to be in harmony with the truth.

Catechism of the Catholic Church #1798

Everyone must avail himself of the means to correctly form his conscience.

Catechism of the Catholic Church #2240

Submission to authority and coresponsibility for the common good make it morally obligatory to pay taxes, to defend one's own country, and exercise the right to vote.
